Bacon Wrapped Shrimp by Tony Baroni

 Brine the shrimp to hold in the moisture in a salt, sugar, and water bath for no more than 30 minutes before you cook them. Add ice too. (1/4 cup of each and 4 cups of water)

- Pre-cook the bacon. A quick microwave strip will ensure crispy bacon and cook at the same time as the shrimp.
- Coat the shrimp with the zest of a lemon and voodoo seasoning on the shrimp.
- Wrap a slice of bacon around it and skewer it. Brush 2 tablespoons of EVOO on them.
- Then place on the grill. Grill for 3 minutes on each side or if baking in the oven, 400 degrees for 8-11 minutes. My favorite is on the grill. YUMMY!
