FREE Things to Do this Summer in Tampa Bay



Always check the Hillsborough County Library website as they offer presentations, classes, puppet shows, reading group time and more. Everyone needs a good summer book to read too.



Beach Time! Stroll the shops at John's Pass Village, sit in the sand at Anna Maria, and visit the new pier in St. Pete.



Lettuce Lake Park in Tampa, guided free nature walks on the weekend or go anytime and walk the boardwalk. (\$2.00 per car entrance fee)



Free movies in the park is a great family date night. Tampa Riverwalk and Clearwater Sunset Festival at the Pier offers free movies paired with performers and live music.



Take a picnic to the free, lush oasis of the Florida Botanical Gardens. Check out the butterfly garden and soothing water fountains.



Tour the Yuengling Brewery for free samples and get to see one of the oldest breweries. 21 and up.



Watch the sunset on the beach, a free show every night.



Check out the concert list and events at Curtis Hixon Waterfront Park.



Tampa Museum of Art, Fridays from 4:00-8:00 it is free to get in.



Make homemade snow cones, ice cream, and popsicles.



Cool off at the 72 degree natural springs water at Lithia Springs Park. (\$2.00 per car entrance fee)

Make Summer Memories at Busch Gardens



Opening in 1959 and about an hour and a half from Disney sits **Busch Gardens Theme Park**. With this park being both an amusement thrill park and zoo meshed together, it meets the needs of multiple family members and all ages. Our family loves the swimming hippos and the larger than life crocodiles but our favorite animal experience is the majestic walk through the **Myombe Reserve** to see the gorillas. Every once in a while you will be lucky enough to feel as if they are looking right into your eyes. Do you have the need for speed? The new **Iron Gwazi is open at Busch Gardens** and it boasts the tallest, steepest, and fastest hybrid rollercoaster in North America. **Cheetah Hunt** is also a must do rollercoaster and just so happens to be the park's longest ride. One of Busch Garden's most well themed rides is the Egyptian inspired spin coaster, Cobra's Curse.



Finally, Montu makes almost any Busch Gardens must events at the park we would highly recommend such do list. When you get too hot, head over to the **Congo River Rapid ride** where you are sure to get cooled off. Close by you can start to smell the **Zambia Smokehouse**.

This spot is one of the best places for lunch, where all the meat is smoked on a wood fire each day. Take the little ones to see the Elmo show and explore the **Serengeti by** taking the Express Train and watch the exotic animals, like the giraffe and zebras, roaming about. Midday snack? Try the pretzel shop and grab a beer in the shade while the kids hit **Falcon's Fury**. When you have had enough walking, head to the ice skating show in Morocco, near the front entrance, for a great indoor air conditioned show.

With a **Fun Card**, you can come all year and they have some great as Summer Nights with fireworks, Howl O Scream in the Fall, and Christmas Town.

Also, across the street, Adventure Island opens the

world's first dueling saucers in the new Rapids Racer and opens the refurbished Wahoo Remix with synchronized lights and sound elements. Last stop of the day, by the front entrance is Sultan's Sweet. Grab a dessert or an ice cream cone as you walk to your car and share your favorite thing about the day.

Insider Tips: Be there at park opening, wear comfortable shoes and sunscreen. You can rent a locker at every roller coaster entry point but you are not permitted to take anything on or in the attraction line. If you can swing just a "fannie pack" you will save money and time.
