

Who loves a good waterpark? Universal's Volcano Bay might just be our new favorite summer day pick. It is described as a theme park with lots of water because it offers all the theme park thrills with the ease of virtual lines with an arm band that will alert you when to head to the ride. It is the newest water park in Central Florida with 27 acre tropical water park and 18 attractions and water slides PLUS

the best lazy river we have found which includes a "not so lazy" rapid river and a wave pool. We thing it is a Must Do.

Tony Baroni Team Family Tips for a Great Day:

- 1. Always arrive early. If it starts to storm in the afternoon everything will shut down, but if it is just a little rain.... keep playing. Many people will leave and less people equals more fun.
- 2. Set up cashless payment through your armband and you can enjoy drinks and food on the go without the hassle of running back to your locker for your wallet.
- **3.** Bring sunglasses, towels (you can rent

them too) and sunscreen. Find your spot and claim it. Grab a locker for your money, phone, and valuables. Lifejackets are provided and, in some attractions, required.

4. Most Popular Attraction: the Krakatau Aqua Coaster. It's a roller coaster and a water slide all in one! Don't leave without riding it but check height restrictions so no one in your group is in tears that they can't ride.

- **5.** If you aren't into riding all day there are several beaches to lounge by, a wave pool, waterfall pool and a lazy river for relaxing.
- **6.** Don't miss the hidden Waterfall Cove near the edge of Krakatau by the reef for your social media selfies. It's gorgeous.

They also offer vacation souvenir and attire shopping and tons of food options with 4 restaurants, snack stations, and two full bars.

> They offer everything from pulled pork. chicken sandwiches and hamburgers to salads. You can mobile order your food as well. Park hours vary depending on the year so always check before hand but usually opens around 10am. PRO TIP: If you are staying on property at Universal you can get in 1 hour early. Volcano Bav is in walking distance from Cabana Bay, Sapphire Falls, and Aventura Hotels. No parking on site. You park in the garage and are bussed over. So float away in the Florida Sun and make the most out of your Summer at the TB Team's Family Summer Pick—Volcano Bay.



PLAN AHEAD It is almost Hurricane Season

Hurricane Season runs from June 1-November 30th with the peak of the Hurricane Season being September 10th. Most activity in Tampa Bay however, happens around mid Augustmid October. So this means that May is a perfect month to get some items done BEFORE a storm approaches your area. As always, please review your Insurance Policy now and talk it over with an expert to fully understand your coverage. Also, be aware if you are in a Flood Zone and what Evacuation Zone you are in and what your plan would be IF you had to leave. Don't forget about your pets too.





Before Hurricane Season Starts

- **1.** Do a thorough Roof check and take care of any missing shingles, damage, or leaks. Clean those gutters while you are up there.
- 2. Make sure your Garage Door is in working order.
- **3.** Check windows for leaking, cracks, damage or if in need of replacing.
- **4.** Trim all large trees around your property, especially those that are in close proximity to your home.
- 5. Get Palm Trees trimmed. You can even ask for a "hurricane" cut.
- **6.** Stock your supplies. Don't do the panic water shopping. Buy water now. Experts recommend 1 Gallon per person, per day.
- **a.** Gather batteries, non-perishables, flashlights, trash bags, first aid kit, medication, and extra pet food. It is nice to have extra toilet paper, paper towels, baby wipes, and a tarp on hand as well. You can put all these items in a tote and have it ready if you ever need it.

When A Hurricane or Tropical Storm is Coming, What Should You Do To Keep Your Home Safe?

- Move anything outside that can be picked up by wind, indoors. Some patio furniture can even be tossed into your pool as well.
- If you have a pool drain it a bit before the rain comes.
- If you live by the water or ocean, boarding windows might be needed. (Have the supplies ahead of time)
- Have a cooler ready if you lose power to move food to keep it cooler.
- Make extra ice and use old water bottles to fill up with ice water. This can be used to keep food cold and drink it later as well.
- Charge all phones and electronics.
- Turn your AC up to keep your home cooler longer.
- If you have a generator fill up extra propane.
