Top 5 Frightfully Haunted Places in Tampa


1. Tampa Theater opened in 1926 as one of the country's most elaborate movie theaters. After ticket sales started to take a nosedive in the 70s the people of Tampa rallied being it and kept it maintained. Many sightings, odd feelings and noises have been documented over the years. Watch wear you sit too...Seat 308 appears to have the ghostliest reports inside the theater. Professional investigators stated that there appears to be both video and audio evidence of someone in that seat. Some ghosts even have names and long history with the theater. For instance, Fink Finkley a long-time projectionist who suffered a heart attack there, has been seen in photographs and some have reported smelling his smoke from his pipe. Robert Lanier, a ticket taker in the 50s, was murdered one night after his shift, his skull bashed in, his murderer never found. Staff report hear his keys jingling in the night and footsteps on the stairs. Rosa, who lived to be 107-year-old, was an organ player at the theater. Music has been heard in the theater and the power often flickers with organ playing in on the big screen.



2. I-4 is 132-mile highway that extends from Tampa to Orlando, with just over 1 death per mile, it is the most dangerous highway in the United States. But it doesn't get its name of the Dead Zone from fatal accidents, it gets its name from being haunted! The government bought the land in the 1960s to build the highway, at this time it was used as a graveyard. Instead of moving the bodies as told, the workers covered everything with dirt and paved over it. There is a particular ¼ mile stretch that as had more accidents than any other part of the road combined. Driver's report seeing bouncing lights, apparitions walking on the side of the road, no cell service, and radios in the cars going silent.

3. Plant Hall, University of Tampa used to be a 500-room hotel in the 1890s. Teddy Roosevelt and Babe Ruth are just a few celebrities that have stayed there. After it was converted to a place of education, students started reporting different things that had happened to them. The most popular sightings are a couple waltzing in the ballroom, footsteps in the hall, cold air in students faces and sounds of servants bringing trays down the halls. Some reported seeing a man with a brown suit on and red eyes believing it might be Henry B Plant himself. Staff have been told never to look directly in his eyes. UT is considered one of the most haunted campuses in America.





4. Ybor City Cuban Club – You can't talk about ghostly sightings without adding Ybor City to the list. The Cuban Club, 1917, which has had multiple deaths occur inside, is probably the most haunted of all. Many report pianos playing by themselves, elevators running at odd times up and down alone, a young boy playing ball in the foyer, and steps on the stairs. The Travel Channel named the Cuban Club one of its Top 10 Most Haunted Places.

5. Don Vicente Hotel, Ybor which use to be used as a medical clinic in the late 1800s. The hotel basement was used as a place for horrific experiments by a crazed doctor and there was an incinerator that was used to burn bodies. Worker's report to this day, eerie giggling, screams, power turning off and on, and the smell of burning flesh.
